Statement of Cooperation

I give permission for my child's teacher and/or other agent of the school to make and enforce classroom regulations in a manner consistent with Christian principles and discipline as set forth in the Scriptures.

I further agree to hold the school and its agents harmless for any liability to my child or any guardian or parent thereof because of any claims on behalf of my child against the school or any agent thereof because of any injury or alleged injury to my child. Should legal action, for any reason, be taken against CedarWood Christian Academy, or any employee or agent thereof, on my child's behalf and the school or its agent not be found at fault, I agree to pay any attorney fees, damages or other costs that CedarWood Christian Academy or its agent should incur to defend itself against such action.

This Statement of Cooperation will be in effect for as long as my child listed attends CedarWood Christian Academy whether it be in the kindergarten, elementary, junior-senior high or summer school.

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Corporal Correction Release

CedarWood Christian Academy is honored that you have asked our staff to assist you in training your child for Christian leadership. Our total program is designed to develop the spiritual and academic qualities that characterize your child. We appreciate your confidence in our program. To carry out your wishes for total character development, we believe it is necessary to follow the Scriptural admonition to correct a child when his behavior is in violation of proper or reasonable rules and procedures. When warranted, corporal punishment will be exercised under the following guidelines:

1. A call will be placed to the home or work number to inform parents of the violation and to give parents the opportunity to come and administer correction. The student will not be re-admitted until discipline is handled. At parent's request or at unavailability of parents at listed phone number, the school will follow the regular stated guidelines.
2. The offense will be clearly discussed with your child.
3. A staff member will discuss Scriptural applications and will pray with your child.
4. Three (3) swats will be administered by a staff member of the same sex as your child, using a simple, flat paddle.
5. A staff witness will be present.
6. Your child will not be physically restrained. (If he or she refuses to submit to paddling, you will be asked to the school to discuss the matter; and if it is believed to be in the best interest of the school, the child will be withdrawn from school.)
7. After administering the strokes, the staff member will pray with your child, assuring him/her of God's love and complete forgiveness, as well as his/her love.
8. A written record will be made of the date, offense, number of strokes, and name of correcting staff member and witness. A copy will be sent to you.

I have read the above and agree to support the school in its policy of corporal punishment without reservation, and personally pledge my support to this Scriptural approach to discipline for:
